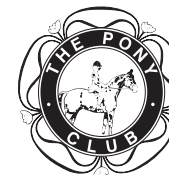


### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Entries close on Monday 2<sup>th</sup> June 2008 - no refund if you cancel after this date. Please use the official entry form only and these must be sent to the Secretary with the appropriate fee. Late entries may be accepted at an additional £1 per class – telephone the Secretary between 8 and 8.30 pm on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> June. withdrawals must be notified to the Secretary to allow those on a waiting list to be fitted into classes.
2. Rider`s age as of 1st January, 2008.
3. The Competition will run under Pony Club Dressage Rules and the Rules for Pony Club Dressage and Jumping competitions, except where otherwise stated. All tests may be called without penalty.
4. Teams may be declared on the day, BEFORE the start of the classes concerned, providing original class entries have been made. Team entries to the Secretary`s caravan with fee.
5. **Dressage times will be available from the Secretary on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m.**
6. Objections, accompanied by a deposit of £10, should be made to the Secretary in writing within 15 minutes of the completion of a class. The Chief Steward`s decision is final classes 5B and 6B in the event of a tie, all four scores will count
7. The Organizers reserve the right to eliminate any competitor whose riding helmet does not conform to Pony Club standards and is not adequately secure when mounted.
8. SPURS – any competitor wishing to wear spurs must carry **written** consent from their DC . (unless holding “B” test ).
